Achievements

I currently preside over approximately fifty (50) cases consisting of various utility matters (electric, telecommunications, water, and sewer) that are under administrative review.

I issue orders on multiple cases on a daily basis in response to motions, responses, and recommendations in order to facilitate effective proceedings and keep each case on track. I also issue multiple notices of approval or notices of deficiency on utility applications on a daily basis depending on whether the applicant has met all of the conditions required by statute and commission rule. I review commission staff's recommendations in the petitions and applications that I preside over, however I conduct my own analysis on all aspects of each case to determine whether the recommendation is accurate prior to issuing any order or notice. Further, I regularly conduct legal research on utility matters concerning the Public Utility Regulatory Act ("PURA"), Texas Water Code ("TWC"), and commission rules.

I have a comprehensive understanding of the applicable TWC statutes and commission rules regarding water and sewer utilities due to my prior work at TCEQ. In order to develop a similar understanding regarding electric and telecommunications utilities, I extensively reviewed and outlined the PURA statutes and commission rules.

Achievements

I held multiple, contemporaneous roles at TCEQ.

As a litigation attorney, I managed enforcement actions that covered multiple medias (including public water systems, wastewater systems, petroleum storage tanks, recycling facilities, etc.) and represented the Executive Director in contested case hearings before SOAH. I provided legal guidance to the Executive Director, Office of Compliance and Enforcement, Water Supply Division, and Regional staff on various issues including enforcement protocol,

regulatory authority, and responses to public information act requests. Further, I negotiated and drafted Compliance Agreements for regulated entities on behalf of the Office of Compliance and Enforcement.

As the lead attorney handling Emergency Orders for water and sewer utilities, I drafted orders that were issued directly by the Executive Director and subsequently approved by the Commission at agenda. This role required coordination with the Public Utility Commission and the Office of the Attorney General to appoint Temporary Managers and Receivers for the utilities and required me to prepare for a potential evidentiary hearing at SOAH for each Emergency Order. Further, I presented each Emergency Order to the Commission at agenda.

As the lead attorney handling the Supplemental Environmental Projects ("SEP"), I negotiated and drafted the SEP contracts that were entered into by the Executive Director and outside entities and provided comments to proposed legislative changes to the SEP Statute (Tex. Water Code § 7.067).
